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Purpose Statement:

ENROLLMENT

Children must be 2 by August 1st. Two-year old's do not need to be potty-trained. Children ages 3 and up do need to be potty-trained.

AGES:

We accept children 2-6 years of age. (Must be 2 by August 1st)

SCHOOL DAYS/HOURS:

School hours are 9:30-2:00.

Before/After care is offered from

7:00a.m.-9:30a.m. & 2:00p.m.-5:30p.m. for an extra fee.

Class options are: Tuesday/Thursday Only for 2's and 3's- \$230 month/\$2,300 year

Monday/Wednesday/Friday- \$340 month/\$3,400 year

Monday-Friday- \$560 month/\$5,600 year

*Concord W.E.E. School is a tuition based preschool. We have broken that down into 10 equal payments. Please note, due to the late August start date the first and second monthly payments are close together.

REGISTRATION FEE:

(Cash & Check)

\$55 registration fee, due at the time of registration by March 31st

\$75 registration fee, due at time of registration from April 1st - May 31st

\$110 registration fee, due at time of registration from June 1st until school begins
