ENROLLMENT Children must be 2 by August 1st. Pre-k students must be potty-trained.

AGES: We accept children 2-6 years of age. (Must be 2 by August 1st)

SCHOOL DAYS/HOURS: School hours are 9:30 - 2:00.

Before/After care is offered from

7:00 a.m.- 9:30 a.m. & 2:00 p.m.- 5:00 p.m. for an extra fee.

Class options are Tuesday/Thursday Only for 2's and 3's - \$280 month/\$2,800-year

Monday/Wednesday/Friday - \$390 month/\$3,900 year

Monday-Friday - \$610 month/\$6,100 year

*Concord W.E.E. School is a tuition-based preschool. We have broken tuition into 10 equal payments. Please note, due to the late August start date the first and second

monthly payments are close together.

REGISTRATION FEE: \$75 registration fee, due at the time of registration by March 31st

(Cash & Check) \$95 registration fee, due at time of registration from April 1st - May 31st

\$120 registration fee, due at time of registration from June 1st until school begins
